(SECTION B - AFFIDAVIT)

SECTION B (“AFFIDAVIT” STUDENT): *Complete this section if the student is living with a person domiciled in the district, other than the parent or guardian.*

Is the person domiciled in the district, supporting the student without remuneration as if the student were his or her own child, keeping the student for a longer time than the school term and assuming all personal obligations for the student relative to school requirements? Please explain.

(The non-parent/guardian with whom the student will be living must file a sworn statement (Form 111). This person must provide a copy of a lease. If the person does not have a lease the landlord must complete form 114.

It must be clear that the student is not living in the district solely for purposes of receiving a public education. Students are not eligible to attend school as “**affidavit**” students unless the student’s parents or guardian **is not capable** of supporting or providing care for the student due to family or economic hardship.

Please explain the circumstances applicable in this case, with special attention to the parent/guardian’s family and/or economic hardship.

(The parent/guardian must file a sworn statement (Form #112) with documentation to support the claims made.)

It is not necessary that legal guardianship or custody be obtained before a student will be considered for enrollment on an “affidavit” basis.
