## 2018-2019 Pre-Kindergarten Childcare Option for Children of Fair Lawn

The Fair Lawn Board of Education through the Community School is offering a Pre-Kindergarten Childcare Program at Edison.

**Details:**

**The 1<sup>st</sup> Day of the program is SEPTEMBER 5, 2018**

This program is for children born between September 2, 2013 and October 1, 2014 (Ages 4-5) and toilet trained.

**\*LIMITED SPACE IS AVAILABLE\***

The tuition is \$905 per month plus a one-time non-refundable registration fee of \$40 for each child.

The program will run Mondays through Fridays from 7:15am – 6:00pm and follow the Fair Lawn Public School Schedule. The program will not operate on days when schools are closed for any reason and no credit will be issued.

\*On delayed opening days the program will open at 9:00am.

The childcare program is designed to introduce many of the academic and social skills taught in kindergarten (daily routines, literacy, math, science, music, art, socialization, free play, and other Pre-K activities).

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## Sample Daily Schedule

**7:15am– 9:00am:** Children arrive and unpack. Cold cereal, milk, and juice are available or you may send in a breakfast from home. When breakfast is completed toys are available for free play until remainder of the children arrives.

**9:00am- 9:15am: Attendance/Flag Salute & Morning Meeting**

Children sit on the carpet together and review the daily message, sight words for the week, and discuss the calendar/weather bear. There is a daily count of how many days of school up to the 100<sup>th</sup> day.

**9:15am- 10:00am: Literacy Lessons/ Small Group Activities**

Each week a new letter of the alphabet is introduced and a lesson in letter recognition sounds, writing of letter, stories, poems ...). An art project based on the letter is usually completed on Friday.

**10:00am– 10:15am: Wash Up/ Bathrooms**

**10:15am – 10:30am: Snack**

Water, juice, or milk and snack are provided or please feel free to send in a snack of your choice.

**10:30am – 11:00am: Music, Dance, Playtime, and Games** (puzzles, stations, gross motor activities...)

Children play together in various groups or play class games (freeze dance, 7-up...).

**11:30am- 12:30pm: Lunch & Recess**

Students eat and socialize during lunch. You must provide lunch with your child.

They may color, take a book, or do puzzles when they finish their lunch.

Weather permitting students may go outside to play.

**12:30pm- 2:00pm: Bathrooms & Quiet Time**

Children will have an opportunity to rest/ nap quietly on the mats.

**2:00pm– 2:30pm: Math Lesson**

A math concept is introduced or reviewed at the rug. Math games and activities accompany the lesson.

**2:30pm - 3:00pm: Art, Science ...**

Children will complete a project that may correspond with a holiday, season, or lesson. When completed it is put on display and then sent home to enjoy.

**3:00am– 3:15am: Wash Up/ Bathrooms**

**3:15pm- 3:30pm: Snack**

Snack and juice are provided.

**3:30pm– 4:00pm: Review Stations and activities**

Review of day's events, lessons, and activities.

**4:00pm– 6:00pm:** Children will do crafts and play games until picked up.

We will also utilize the gym and playground area when weather permitting.

There will be show and tell twice a month and, various other programs. Birthdays and holidays will be celebrated throughout the year.
