

The goal of the newly revised REACH Program is to provide optimal learning experiences that enrich and enhance the learning environment for all students through the development of critical, creative and higher order thinking skills. At this time the program offers an Exploration program for students in grade 3 who have been recognized as having advanced ability in the areas of verbal and non verbal thinking skills. These explorations are offered as Problem Solving/Math and Literacy rotations of eight weeks each. In grades 4 and 5 we offer seminars in the area of Math and Literacy to students who are identified as having advanced skills in those areas based on a matrix of various objective and subjective criteria. In addition we offer a self select reading and math program in grade 4 based on an application process. And in both grades 4 and 5 we offer an Independent Study opportunity as well. In Grade 5 we offer a national analogies program called WordMasters, which is also a self select program.
